Re: Access and Use of the Beaches in Tiny Township

I understand that the public beaches located in Tiny Township have become increasingly difficult to access and there is a new initiative under which these public properties will be treated as though they are a "right of way" thus limiting beach goers to walking only and not permitting anyone to stop and enjoy.

I support the notion that public beaches should remain available for use by all individuals and families and that its use should not be under the control of those adjacent to the public property.
